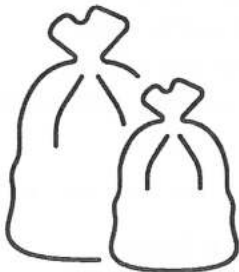

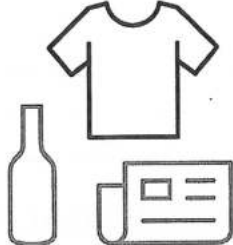

- ✓ Garden waste

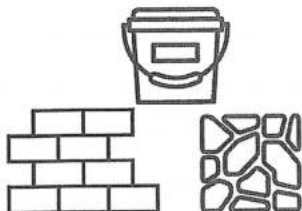


- ✓ Bigger items: toys, small furniture, household items

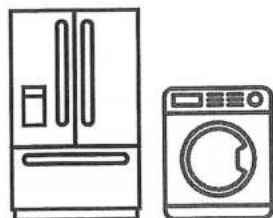


WE CAN'T TAKE

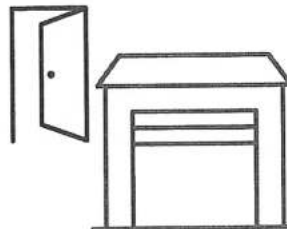
- ✗ Building materials i.e. rubble, concrete, sand, bricks, slabs, full paint pots
